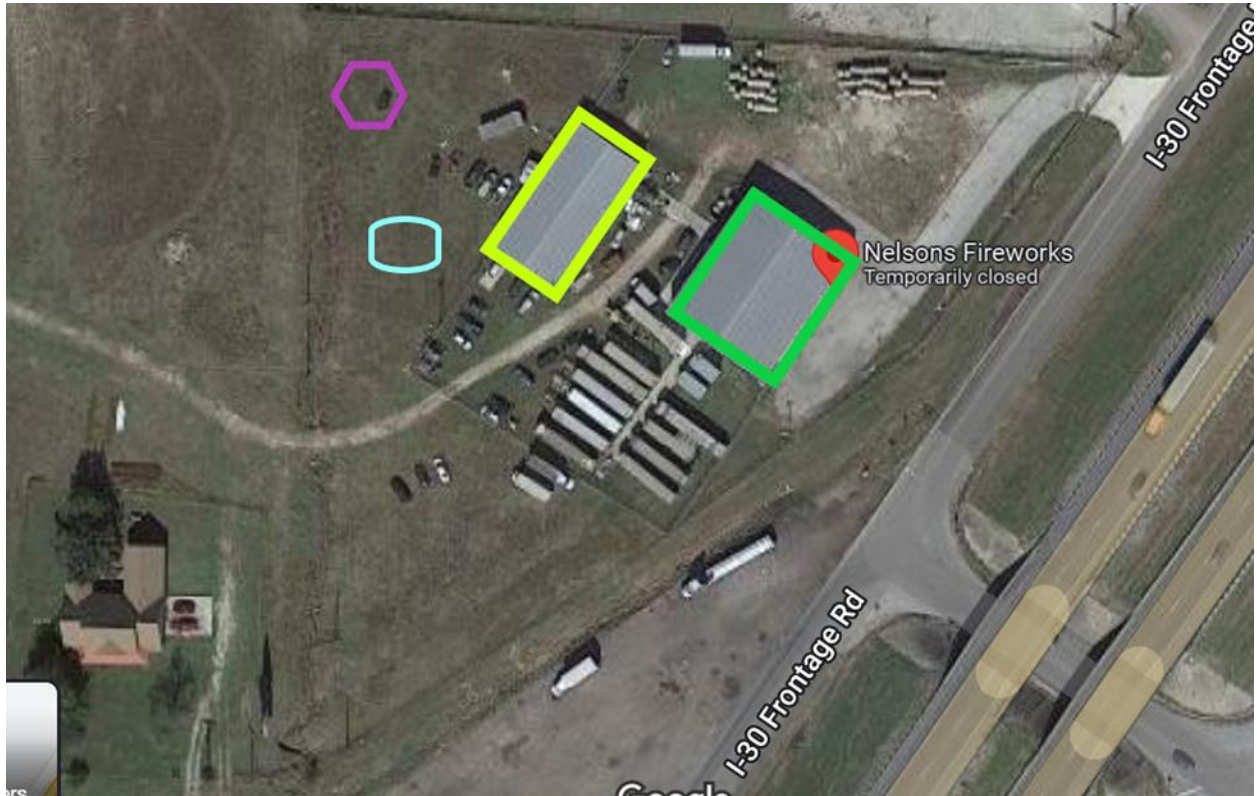


2023 Spring Pyrofest Map

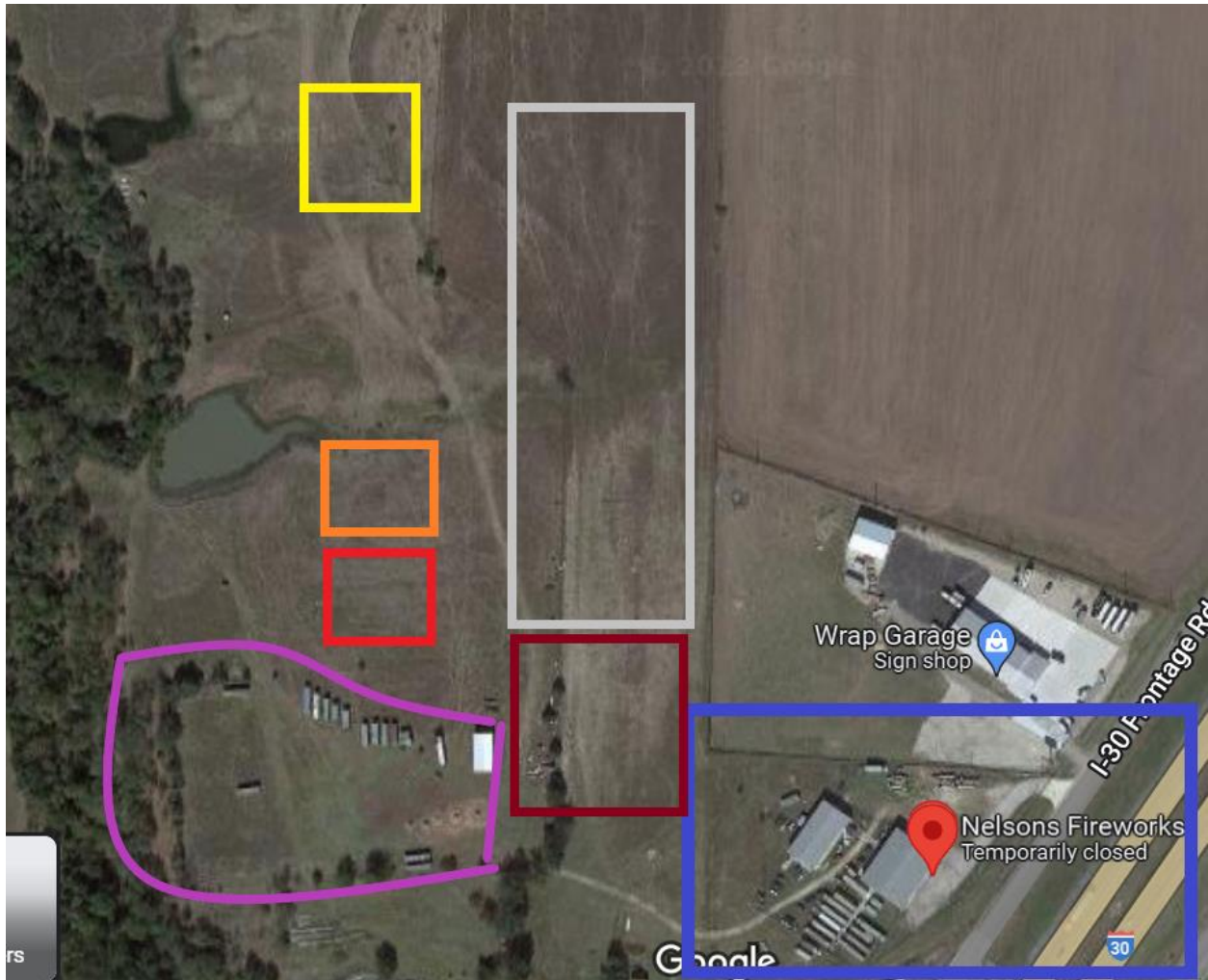


The Green box will be referred to as building 1

The Yellow box will be referred to as building 2

The light blue box will be the Mill.

The Purple Hexagon is the Flash Powder Making area



The purple are is off limits for safety reasons. If access is needed, please speak with Nick Sainz, Jeremy Jandreau, JJ(Jeff Jordan), or Ken Purcell.

The red box is the designated salute line.

The orange box is the designated area for Fuel mines.

The Yellow box is the designated B class fireworks and Rockets

The white/grey box is designated for 1.3g fireworks display setup

The Maroon box is the designated 1.4g display setup

The Blue box is the area contained in the other map

GENERAL RULES FOR SPRING PYROFEST

1. No smoking with 100ft of any manufacturing or setup of any fireworks (duh).
2. If you are new to the club, you **MUST** attend a safety brief. If you can't make the one on Friday, just let them know at registration and they can get someone to go over it with you.
3. If you are in need of a sign off, you will need to work on either the 1.4g or 1.3g displays and be present for clean up.
4. Approach the salute and fuel mine area with caution
5. **DO NOT** use flash photography in any manufacturing area. Seriously, don't make people poop themselves.
6. Flash powder can only be made at the designated location and the amount of Flash open at once should not be much more than is required for the thing being made.
7. If you are unfamiliar with the energetic material being handled, please don't hesitate to ask
8. **DO NOT BE AFRAID TO ASK QUESTIONS**

Schedule:

Open Shooting

Fuel mine area and B line will be open From 1pm to Midnight.

Salute line will be open from 4pm to 10pm on Friday and Noon to 8PM on Saturday.

Class C fireworks can be popped off at the B-line.

They will be closed during the displays as to not interfere with them, but will be open before and after.

Open Manufacturing at the discretion of the equipment owners, anyone new to it should be accompanied by someone with experience.
